

JACK & ROZ KIRBY AWARDS

Join us at OAX on Saturday, February 21 at 5:30 pm EST for **The Jack & Roz Kirby Awards** (The Kirbys). The ceremony will be held at the outdoor pavilion at our venue. Guests are encouraged to arrive early to ensure seating. All attendees will receive an 11x17" print of the commemorative poster.

The Kirbys are an annual award recognizing innovation, excellence, and humanity in narrative communication. For its first year, the Kirbys will consist of seven total award categories that celebrate the artist's journey. The award categories have no time restrictions, aside from the Newcomer Award; no geographic limits; and are English only (original/translated). Nominees must be alive at the time of nomination and, after winning a Kirby Award, are ineligible to be nominated for another five years.

CORE AWARDS

The five Core Awards reflect attributes of Jack Kirby and of dedicated, lifelong creators. Voting Committee members have the exclusive responsibility to provide up to two nominations per category and are the sole voters for these categories.

INDEPENDENCE – *"One who remains steadfast and fierce"*

The nominee has demonstrated the ability to operate outside the confines of established systems and control structures to freely create works that express deeply personal beliefs, themes, and values without censorship and commercial pressure.

INNOVATOR – *"One distinguished by new methods, approaches, and ideas"*

The nominee has demonstrated clear innovation in methods, techniques, styles, storytelling, solutions, and/or packaging, and in so doing, has challenged the status quo and expanded the possibilities for all.

VISIONARY – *"One distinguished by vital originality"*

The nominee has demonstrated the ability to display and communicate worlds, characters, ideas, symbols, and realities beyond our current norms and understanding in contributing to our general comprehension and evolution.

NEWCOMER – *"One to support in all ways"*

The nominee has demonstrated early in their artistic life unique capabilities, viewpoints, perspectives, dedication, and perseverance that invites the possibility of consistently unique and impactful works being created.

STORYTELLER – *"One adept at shared human connection"*

The nominee has demonstrated the ability to synthesize the complex and varied components of storytelling to powerfully connect with, engage, and impact others.

LEGACY AWARDS

The two Legacy Awards are a type of career achievement award. The Teacher award is rooted in a fundamental character trait of a distinguished creator, and the Creator award recognizes the underlying quality, innovation, importance, and distinction of a creator's body of work. Nominations are electively provided by all Oversight Council, Advisory Board, and Voting Committee members and then voted on by the Oversight Council and Voting Committee.

CREATOR – *"One whose life's work is exemplar for those to come"*

The nominee has demonstrated the desire, ability, and commitment to time and again reenter the creative process and engage the often unpredictable and arduous creative journey towards conveying to us new stories, characters, themes, symbols, and possibilities.

TEACHER – *"One who suspends self and readily bestows experience and guidance"*

The nominee has demonstrated the rare and critical ability to take that which they've experienced and learned, and in a natural and discerning manner, communicate their knowledge to others in a way that's timely, uplifting, and impactful.



The Jack Kirby Museum & Research Center presents Jack Kirby's KAMANDI #7 (July 1973) original art, including 20 interior pages plus cover. If that's not enough, most of the pages are paired with prints of Kirby's studio pencil photocopies for a rare pencils-to-inks view of the story's creation, from Kirby's first pencil decisions to Mike Royer's finished inked pages. From the collection of Tom Kraft.

X-Men of Apocalypse #2

The X-Men of Apocalypse have gone back to where it all began in their quest to restore their history! This special gallery will be the first opportunity to purchase all 20 original interior art pages created by Simone Di Meo, from the story written by Jeph Loeb. Micro Computer Detective

Artist: Yoshiaki Shimojou

Story: Mitsuru Sugaya

Micro Computer Detective follows the high stakes exploits of Daisuke Yazaki, a young genius who uses his technical mastery of early microcomputing to outmaneuver a violent gang of motorcycle bank robbers. This series perfectly captured the 1980s fascination with the burgeoning digital frontier, blending classic hard-boiled detective tropes with "cutting-edge" computer science. Artist Yoshiaki Shimojou brings this technological thriller to life with a sharp, dynamic style. His work is notable for its detailed rendering of period-accurate hardware—a hallmark of the "tech-manga" subgenre. Shimojou's ability to visualize abstract data processing and technical expertise into high-tension action sequences made the series a standout for readers captivated by the dawn of the personal computer age. Experience this complete 38-page chapter, which features a mix of standard and "large-format" two-tone pages, showcasing the original manuscript dimensions before they were scaled down for publication.
